









<p><u>Candy Cane</u> £14.00pp (B/I)</p> <p>This longer length fun necklace is perfect for summer – lightweight, versatile and bang up-to-date. You will be taught the importance of balance & how to form neat loops for linked connections.</p> <p>You will need: 15-20 Acrylic ‘gem’ beads 16-21 Large sp/gp thick jumprings (one more than the number of acrylic beads you have) 1 x sp/gp toggle clasp</p> <p>All other findings will be provided</p>	<p><u>Dot Dash</u> £19.00pp (B/I)</p> <p>Learn how to make beautiful byzantine link chainmaille and wrap an Indian –loop. In this class we team the byzantine link with focal beads to create a wonderfully wearable and aesthetically pleasing piece. Beware...it will be the start of an addiction!</p> <p>You will need: 100 sp or gp 8mm thick jumprings 6 focal beads 1 x sp or gp trigger clasp</p> <p>All extra findings will be provided</p>	<p><u>Starburst Ring</u> £16.00pp (B/I)</p> <p>Create a sparkly piece of ring bling! You’ll use illusion cord and faceted crystal to weave a beautiful starburst ring that will surely dazzle.</p> <p>You will need: Up to 120 4mm bicone crystals or 4mm faceted Czech glass beads 1 x adjustable sieve ring Illusion Cord</p> <p>Class taught by Justine Jones</p>
<p><u>Tin Cup Necklace</u> £16.00pp (B)</p> <p>The ‘tin cup’ necklace is the perfect piece to learn how to knot pearls and beads. Your teacher has knotted hundreds of necklaces and will show you how easy it actually is. By the end of this class you’ll have learned how to knot pearls into position and end a threaded necklace. If we’ve time we’ll also show you how to use your newly acquired skills to make beautiful matching earrings!</p> <p>You will need: 19 x 6mm-10mm freshwater pearls (approx) (Optional - 38 Preciosa 4mm bicone crystals) 2 x sp or gp clamshell ends Sp or gp clasp Sp or gp extension chain</p> <p>Thread, head pins, jumprings and earring hooks will be provided.</p>	<p><u>Morsesque Necklace</u> £25.00pp (I) DESIGN MASTERCLASS</p> <p>A fabulous, decadent creation. Create a designer style necklace without the price tag! This necklace uses chunky beads separated by multi-strand clusters of gemstones, sparkling Swarovski crystals and freshwater pearls.</p> <p>You will need: 9-11 x Large focal beads 50-60 x Briolette drilled teardrop beads 50 x 2mm SP round beads 50 -60 Preciosa 4mm bicone crystals 200 Small mixed 3-4mm beads in complimentary colour scheme Sp Toggle clasp</p> <p>Tigertail, and all findings will be provided</p>	<p><u>Dewdrop Necklace</u> £14.00pp (B)</p> <p>This is the stalwart of many a beading class, and for good reason-it’s one of the best ways to learn the fundamentals of necklace and bracelet making! You’ll learn about positioning, how to crimp and how to end a tigertail necklace using clamshell ends. The techniques you learn can be used to make bracelets and adapted to make earrings.</p> <p>You will need: 20 x sp or gp crimps (small size) 9 x focal beads - 8mm or larger 18 x Preciosa 4mm bicone crystals 1 x sp or gp lobster clasp 1 x sp or gp extension chain 2 x sp or gp clamshell ends 2 x sp or gp jumprings</p> <p>Tigertail and extra findings will be provided</p>
<p><u>Pebbles Necklace</u> £15.00pp (B)</p> <p>This class teaches you how to make an easy-to-wear knotted necklace combining the natural simplicity of woven cotton with your choice of feature beads. This piece looks great with a shirt collar or over a high neck...perfect for the chilly weather...</p> <p>You will need: 16-18 x Focal beads - 6mm or larger with holes to take 1mm cord 3m woven cord 1 x sp/ gp lobster clasp 1 x sp/ gp extension chain 2 x sp/ gp foldover clamps 2 x sp/gp jumprings</p> <p>Tigertail and extra findings will be provided</p>	<p><u>Droplets Necklace</u> £14.00pp (B)</p> <p>This class is one of the best ways to learn the fundamentals of necklace and bracelet making! You’ll learn how to crimp and how to end a multistrand tigertail necklace using clamshell ends. The techniques you learn can be used to make bracelets and adapted to make earrings.</p> <p>You will need: A selection of 30-50 beads, all sizes. 1 x sp or gp lobster clasp 1 x sp or gp extension chain 2 x sp or gp clamshell ends 2 x sp or gp jumprings</p> <p>Tigertail, crimps and extra findings will be provided</p>	<p><u>Earring Essentials</u> £14.00pp (B)</p> <p>Earrings are one of the easiest items of jewellery to make but their creation requires techniques which are fundamental skills. Learn about the many findings and components used to make earrings and see how quick it is to make a pair (or four)!</p> <p>You will need: 20 x sp or gp headpins 10 x Preciosa 4mm bicone beads 4 x 6mm glass pearl beads 2 x 8mm glass pearl beads A small selection of beads (in pairs) 1 x 16” Silver plated belcher chain</p> <p>All findings will be provided</p>
<p><u>Felt Handbag</u> £55.00pp (B/I)</p> <p>This class teaches you the clever technique of single-piece felt forming – no stitching together required! In the morning we’ll show you how to make felt from scratch and make it into your handbag. After lunch you’ll create a coordinating beaded handle, attach a button closure and embellish.</p> <p>You will need – to be purchased on the day: A selection of beads to make up your desired length of handle A large button to act as your closure All other materials will be provided.</p> <p>Felt making taught by Heather Potten.</p>	<p><u>Timepiece</u> £14.00pp (B/I)</p> <p>You’ll use elastic and your own choice of beads to create a one-of-a-kind watch. Dress it up with sparkly Preciosa crystal or create a more casual look with natural beads such as nut or wood.</p> <p>You will need: 5-6” worth of your choice of beads 1 x single loop watch face</p> <p>All other findings will be provided</p> <p>Please note: The number of beads you will need is dependent on how large you require the watch to be...if in doubt buying a few more means you won’t be caught short!</p>	<p><u>Felt Flower Pin</u> £25.00pp (B)</p> <p>Felt, combining the soft warmth of fine fibre with the decorative possibilities of colour and texture, is a perfect medium for creating stunning adornments. Using fine merino wool in a fabulous range of colours, you will learn how to lay out the fibres, apply wet felting techniques and finally mould your piece to create a unique flower pin. For the centre, you will be able to choose a focal bead of your choice before adding the pin that will complete your creation.</p> <p>All materials will be provided.</p>

Things you need to know:
