










<p><b><u>Spec-tacular</u></b>      <b>£14.00pp</b>      <b>(All levels)</b></p> <p>We think spectacle wearers have the right to glamorous and desirable 'spec chains'. Hence why we've designed this class. You'll create a beaded spectacle 'chain' that can't be bought - except if you sell it!</p> <p>You will need: A selection of beads from 4-10mm –enough for 28" 2 x spectacle chain ends</p> <p>Tigertail and all extra findings will be provided</p>	<p><b><u>Pearlescence</u></b>      <b>£25.00pp</b>      <b>(B/I)</b></p> <p>We've all seen them - fabulous scarves of pearls adorning jeweller's window displays. Now you can make your own for a fraction of the cost and in a colour scheme of your choice. Basic pearl knotting will be taught on this class.</p> <p>You will need: 3 - 4 x 16" strands of pearls - all same colour is fine but mixed sizes and colours add texture &amp; interest 2 x larger feature pearls/gemstones for the ends</p> <p>Needles, thread and findings will be provided.</p>	<p><b><u>Erawan Necklace</u></b>      <b>£14.00pp</b>      <b>(B)</b></p> <p>This elegant necklace oozes style, is delicate enough to be worn with the lightest of fabrics and showcases your beautiful beads. This class focuses on created wrapped loop links.</p> <p>You will need: 9 x glass focal beads 6 x sp or gp 3mm spacer beads 18 x sp or gp beadcaps 16" plated belcher chain (with clasp)</p> <p>Wire and extra findings will be provided</p>
<p><b><u>Droplets Necklace</u></b>      <b>£14.00pp</b>      <b>(B)</b></p> <p>This class is one of the best ways to learn the fundamentals of necklace and bracelet making! You'll learn how to crimp and how to end a multistrand tigertail necklace using clamshell ends. The techniques you learn can be used to make bracelets and adapted to make earrings.</p> <p>You will need: A selection of 30-50 beads, all sizes. 1 x sp or gp lobster clasp 1 x sp or gp extension chain 2 x sp or gp clamshell ends 2 x sp or gp jumprings</p> <p>Tigertail, crimps and extra findings will be provided</p>	<p><b><u>Springtime Earrings</u></b>      <b>£16.00pp</b>      <b>(B/I)</b></p> <p>Create a sparkly piece of earring bling! You'll use illusion cord and faceted crystal to weave a beautiful pair of drop earrings that will surely dazzle. The techniques you'll learn can be adapted to make studs, rings and pendants...the only limit are your imagination!</p> <p>You will need: 22 x 4mm bicone crystals 5 size 15 seed beads 5 sp or gp 3mm beads 1pr x sp or gp earwires Illusion Cord</p> <p>Chain and extra findings will be provided</p>	<p><b><u>Tiara Magic</u></b>      <b>£55.00pp</b>      <b>(B)</b></p> <p>This class introduces you to the skills required to make fabulous tiaras. You will learn how to twist wire efficiently and easily while incorporating crystals and glass pearls and end neatly. Two styles will be demonstrated and you can make either or both!</p> <p>You will need: 2 x SP Tiara band 60 x 4mm preciosa bicone beads (approx) 20 x Swarovski 6mm bicone beads (approx) Mixed selection of glass pearls in 4mm and 6mm</p> <p>All wire will be provided</p>
<p><b><u>Watch Out</u></b>      <b>£12.00pp</b>      <b>(B)</b></p> <p>Differing from our February watch class, this one teaches you how to make an elaticated watch – handy if you aren't sure of wrist sizes! You'll learn professional techniques for finishing and knotting elastic.</p> <p>You will need: 5-6" worth of your choice of beads 1 x single loop watch face 1 x toggle clasp</p> <p>All other findings will be provided</p> <p><b>Please note: The number of beads you will need is dependent on how large you require the watch to be...if in doubt buying a few more means you won't be caught short!</b></p>	<p><b><u>Tin Cup Necklace</u></b>      <b>£16.00pp</b>      <b>(B)</b></p> <p>The 'tin cup' necklace is the perfect piece to learn how to knot pearls and beads. Your teacher has knotted hundreds of necklaces and will show you how easy it actually is. By the end of this class you'll have learned how to knot pearls into position and end a threaded necklace. If we've time we'll also show you how to use your newly acquired skills to make beautiful matching earrings!</p> <p>You will need: 19 x 6mm-10mm freshwater pearls (approx) (Optional - 38 Preciosa 4mm bicone crystals) 2 x sp or gp clamshell ends Sp or gp clasp Sp or gp extension chain</p> <p>Thread, head pins, jumprings and earring hooks will be provided.</p>	<p><b><u>Pearly Picket Fence</u></b>      <b>£14.00pp</b>      <b>(B)</b></p> <p>A great way to create a cuff bracelet without having to master the intricacy of bead weaving. In this class we'll teach you how to make your own headpins and show you how to double-end them to create a 'picket fence' cuff that has wonderful flexibility and is extremely comfortable to wear.</p> <p>You will need: Between 31 and 43 (must be a multiple of 3 plus 1 extra) medium sized freshwater pearls...the larger your wrist the more pearls you'll need. 1 x 16" silver plated curb chain (2-3mm links)</p> <p>Wire and findings will be provided</p>
<p><b><u>Felt Handbag</u></b>      <b>£55.00pp</b>      <b>(B/I)</b></p> <p>This class teaches you the clever technique of single-piece felt forming – no stitching together required! In the morning we'll show you how to make felt from scratch and make it into your handbag. After lunch you'll create a coordinating beaded handle, attach a button closure and embellish.</p> <p>You will need – to be purchased on the day: A selection of beads to make up your desired length of handle A large button to act as your closure All other materials will be provided.</p> <p>Felt making taught by Heather Potten.</p>	<p><b><u>Beading Basics</u></b>      <b>£55.00pp</b>      <b>(B)</b></p> <p>Learn how to make jewellery basics – necklace, bracelet and earrings. Using different beading mediums, we'll teach you how to make a single strand beaded necklace, an elaticated bracelet and wired earrings. We'll teach you ending, tying off knots, creating loops and much more....</p> <p>You will need: 40cm – 50cm selection of beads for the necklace 15cm-20cm selection of beads for the bracelet (with 0.6mm holes or larger) 1cm-3cm paired selection of beads for the earrings</p> <p>All wires, findings etc will be provided</p>	<p><b><u>Felt Flower Pin</u></b>      <b>£22.00pp</b>      <b>(B)</b></p> <p>Felt, combining the soft warmth of fine fibre with the decorative possibilities of colour and texture, is a perfect medium for creating stunning adornments. Using fine merino wool in a fabulous range of colours, you will learn how to lay out the fibres, apply wet felting techniques and finally mould your piece to create a unique flower pin. For the centre, you will be able to choose a focal bead of your choice before adding the pin that will complete your creation.</p> <p>All materials will be provided.</p>
